The Hyde Park Art Center strongly encourages advance registration. Many classes fill quickly. Other classes may be cancelled if there are not at least 5 students pre-registered before the first class meets. A student is not considered registered until payment has been received and a registration form has been completed.

Please note that half sessions are available for most courses, but students must elect to attend classes either the first or second half of the term. All courses meet once a week for the 10 week term unless stated otherwise, and any classes cancelled due to holidays will have make-up class dates arranged at the discretion of the Teaching Artist.
