

## Sample Curriculum

**Name of Class:**

Figure Painting/Drawing: Monday Mornings, 9:30am - 12:00pm

**Media:**

Multimedia: Painting and Drawing

**Grade Levels/Ages:**

Adults

**Description:**

Working from the figure, students develop their own sense of style with their choice of medium from pastel, charcoal, and ink to acrylic and oil painting.

**Learning Objectives:**

- Mainly to have fun with a group of artists while learning how to see artistically.
- Previous drawing experience or beginning drawing recommended.

**Materials:**

Students bring:  
-chosen paints, etc  
-chosen canvases, etc  
-18" x 24" pad of newsprint paper  
-sticks of vine charcoal

**Week-by-Week Description:**

Each class is 2.5 hours. The first half hour, students draw 1-minute gesture poses to warm-up, clear their mind and focus on the figure. The figure poses for 2 hours, standing, seated or reclining, depending on which week and model is booked. There is an additional open studio class scheduled on Monday afternoons, students may register for where the model will continue the same pose to give students a longer time to work on their painting/drawing. Feedback from the instructor is given to students as they are working and a class critique of the 10 weeks of work will be held during the last session. Models are scheduled for two weeks at a time with a variety of skin tones in the male and female models.
